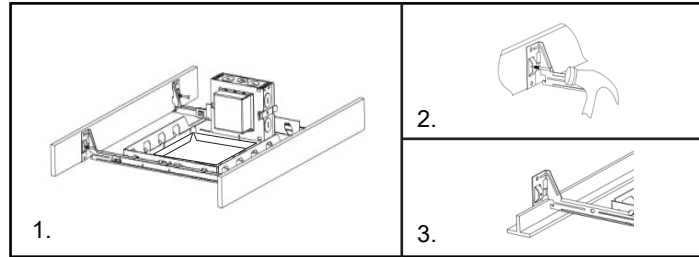


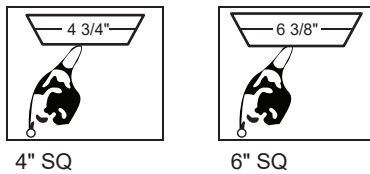
HOUSING INSTALLATION

FASTENING FIXTURE TO CEILING

- Joist-type ceiling-extend bar hangers to fit between joists. Position fixture temporarily by hammering "Nail" into joists. (Drawing2) then secure permanently with nails Hanger should be level with bottom of joists.
- Suspended (T-bar) ceilings-extend bar hangers 1" past T-bars, then rest fixture on T-bars, Secure fixture to T-bars with wire (Drawing3)



1. Cut out a hole 4-3/4" (4" HOUSING) or 6-3/8" (6" HOUSING) in the drywall



2. Install MOUNTING FRAME using ADJUSTABLE MOUNTING BRACKET

3. Adjust MOUNTING FRAME to the proper height by loosening the wing nuts on both adjustable brackets and set the MOUNTING FRAME so that the bottom edge of the FRAME is flush with the finished ceiling Tighten the wing nuts

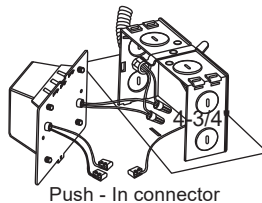
4. Junction box is suitable for branch wiring and is supplied with trade size knockouts and integral Romex connectors

5. For Romex pry open the knock out and push the wire through the clamp plate inside
 - a) Wire connections must be installed in a manner that does not interfere with the strain relief action of the clamp

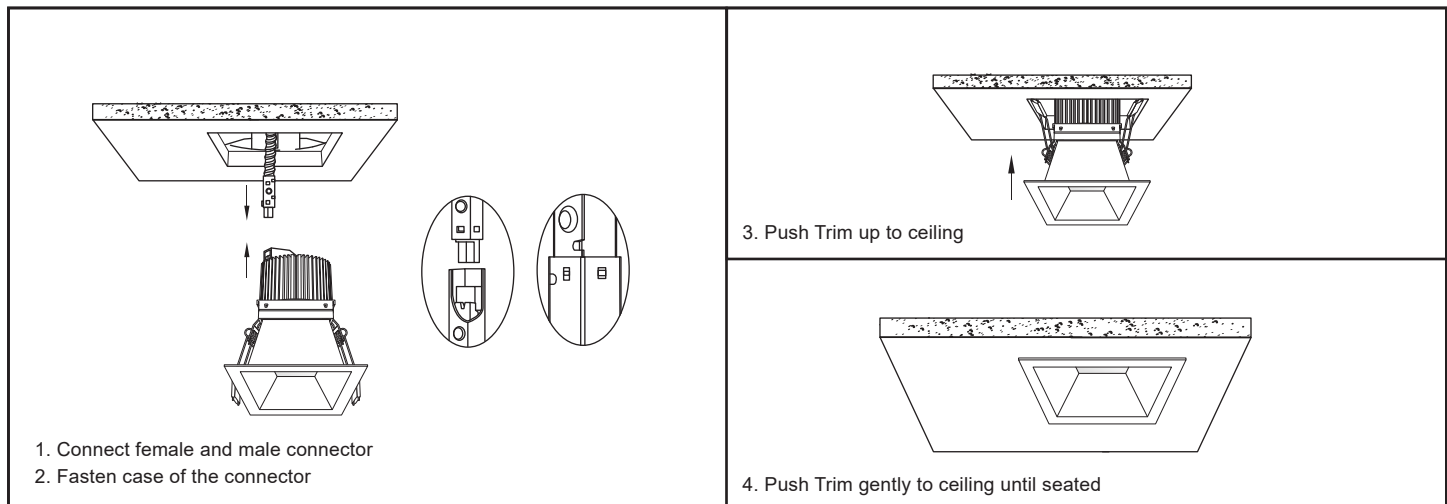
NOTE : Final vertical adjustment can be made by means of WING NUT AND SCREW

ELECTRICAL CONNECTION

1. Open junction box door and connect fixture wires to building wires in the following sequence White fixture wire to white neutral wire black fixture wire to (hot)
2. Use push-in type wire connectors supplied or white nuts
3. Replace junction box door

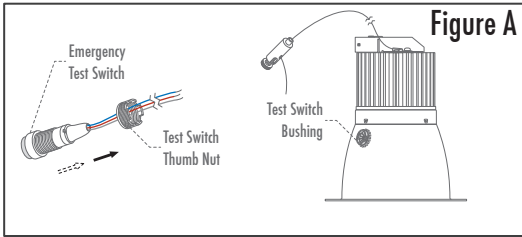

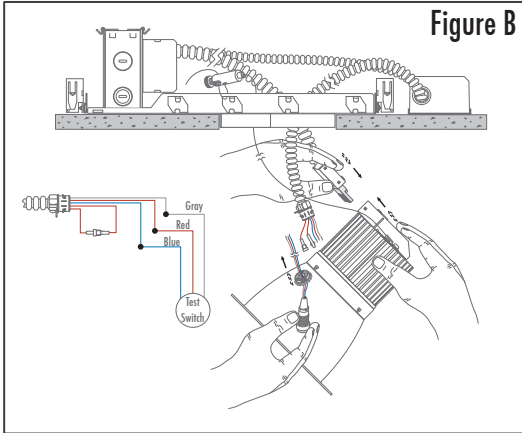

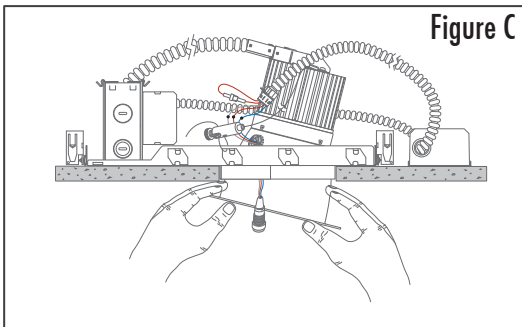

- 2). This luminaire must be connected with supply wire rated at 90°C. Most dwellings built before 1985 have supply wire rated at 60°C; consult a qualified electrician before installing.

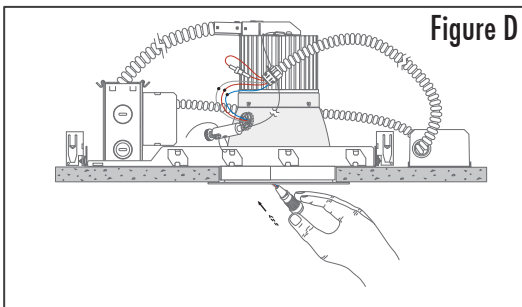


INSTALL TEST SWITCH:

- 1). Remove the Thumb Nut, it's no needed to install the Test Switch in the Reflector. See FIG. A

MAKE CONNECTIONS:

- 2). Insert Test Switch Wires through Bushing, connect Luminaire and hard wire Test Switch (follow Wiring Diagram from Emergency Specifications). See FIG. B

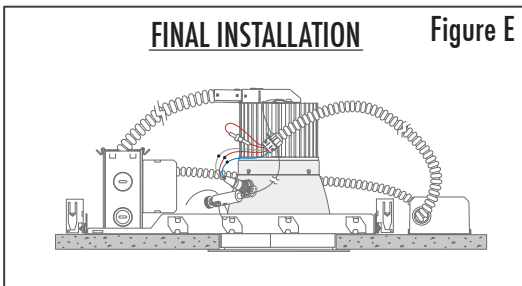


INSTALL LUMINAIRE HOUSING:

- 3). Insert Luminaire through Ceiling Opening and push up until it is secure and tight to the Recessed Frame. See FIG. C

INSTALL TEST SWITCH:

- 4). Insert Test Switch through the Bushing, push it up until it is flush to Reflector Surface. See FIG. D



FINAL INSTALLATION:

- 5). See FIG. E

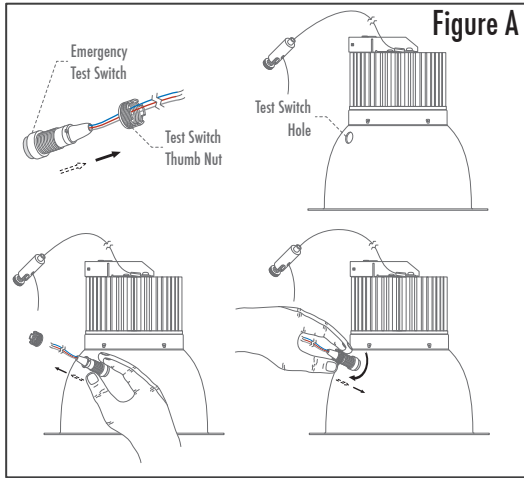

INSTALL LUMINAIRE HOUSING:

- 3). Insert Luminaire through Ceiling Opening and push up until it is secure and tight to the Recessed Frame. See FIG. C

FINAL INSTALLATION:

- 4). See FIG. D

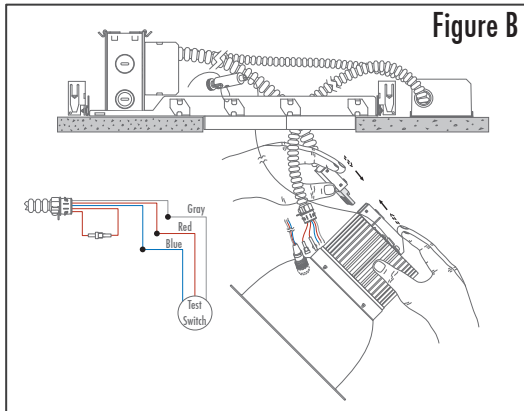

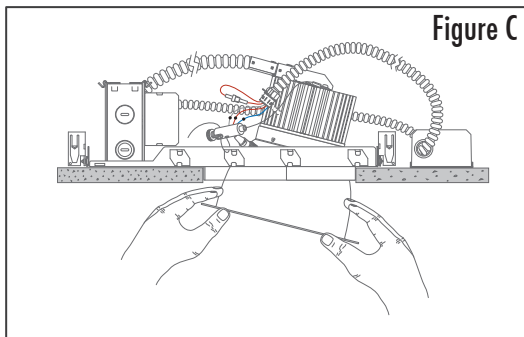
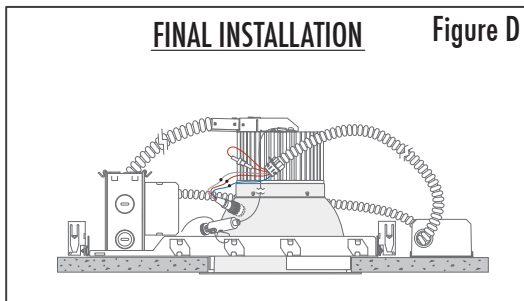
